Instrument Panel

one | Windshield / Wiper Washer The multifunction lever controls the windshield wiper modes, speeds and the windshield washer. Rotate the end of the control away from you to increase the speed of the wipers. Rotate the control towards you to decrease the speed of the wipers.



For windshield washer control, push the end of the stalk briefly to cause a single swipe

of the wiper. With a quick push and hold, the wipers will swipe three times with washer fluid. With a long

two | Foglamp Control With the ignition on, the foglamps can be turned on when the headlamp control is in the parking lamp, headlamp, or autolamp position and the high beams are not on. Simply pull the headlamp control toward you to turn on the foglamps.

The foglamp indicator light will illuminate. The foglamps will not operate when the high beams are activated.



three | Headlamp Control Turning the headlamp control clockwise to the first position turns on the parking lamps, instrument panel lamps, license plate lamps and the tail lamps. Continuing to turn the headlamp control to the second position turns on the headlamps.



headlamp control counterclockwise. If the windshield wipers are turned on for a fixed period of time, exterior lamps will turn on with the headlamp control in the autolamp position. To turn autolamps off, in the control clockwise to the OFF position.

tivate the high beams, simply push the turn signal lever toward the instrument panel. Pull the lever rd you to deactivate high beams. Use the same lever to activate the "Flash to Pass" feature. Pull the toward you slightly to activate and release it to deactivate.

Panel Dimmer Use this control to adjust the brightness of the instrument and all applicable switches in the vehicle during headlamp and parking lamp on. Move the control to the full upright position, past the detent, to turn on the lamps.

Speed Control For your speed control to work, you must press and release button. Pressing and releasing the OFF button disengages the system and off. To set a speed, press the ON button, accelerate to the desired speed and ne SET+ button, then take your foot off the accelerator pedal. You can increase need by pressing and releasing the SET+ button until you reach the desired increasing speed by 1 mph (1.6 km/h) with each tap. You can decrease speed


the same way using the SET- button. Pressing the RSM (resume) button will automatically return the chicle to the previously set speed. To disengage the speed control, press the OFF or CNCL button or epress the brake pedal.

Six | Steering Wheel Audio Controls (if equipped)

from the steering wheel. Press MEDIA to select AM, FM1, FM2
or CD. Press SEEK to access the next/previous strong station

VEN | Tilt Steering Column To adjust the steering wheel, push the istment lever down to unlock the steering column. While the lever is down, tilt to pring column to your desired position. Warning Lights and Message Center

- a Throttle Control/Transmission Lights The throttle control/transmission lights illuminates when a powertrain fault has been detected. Contact your authorized dealer as soon as possible.
- b ABS Warning Light In an emergency, apply continuous force to the brake pedal. Do not pump the brakes. Any pulsation or mechanical noise you may feel or hear is normal. If the light doesn't illuminate or stays on, have your vehicle serviced. Normal braking is still functional unless the brake warning light is also illuminated.
- C | Speed Control Light The speed control light will Illuminate when the speed control is engaged. It will turn off when the speed control system is disengaged. The controls for the speed control are located on the steering wheel. Press and release the ON and OFF buttons to engage and disengage the system. Speed control does not work at speeds below 30 mph (48 km/h). For more information, please consult your Owner's Guide.
- d | Check Engine Light The check engine indicator light illuminates when the ignition is first turned to the ON position to check the bulb. If the lamp turns solid or blinks, the On Board Diagnostics System has detected a malfunction. Drive in a moderate fashion (avoid heavy acceleration or deceleration) and have your vehicle serviced immediately.
- e | Brake System Warning Light To confirm the brake system warning light is functional, it will momentarily illuminate when the ignition is turned to the ON position, when the engine is not running or in a position between ON and START, or by applying the parking brake when the ignition is turned to the ON position. If the brake system warning light does not illuminate at this time, seek service immediately from your dealership. Illumination after releasing the parking brake indicates low brake fluid level and the brake system should be inspected immediately by your servicing dealership.
- f | Message Center | With the ignition in the ON position, the message center displays important vehicle information by constantly monitoring vehicle systems. You may select display features on the message center for a display of status. The system will also notify you of potential vehicle problems with a display of system warnings.
