EASY FUEL™ 'NO CAP' FUEL SYSTEM

Your vehicle has a 'no cap' fuel system which allows you to simply open the fuel filler door, insert the nozzle and start fueling. The Easy Fuel™ system is self-sealing and therefore protected against dust, dirt, water, snow and ice. If you need to fill your fuel tank with a portable fuel container, use the fuel funnel which is attached to the rear of the spare tire compartment. Slowly insert the funnel into the Easy Fuel[™] system and fill the tank with fuel from the container. When done, clean the funnel or properly dispose of it. Extra funnels can be purchased from your authorized dealer. Do not use aftermarket funnels as they will not work with the Easy Fuel™ system and may cause damage.

FUEL TYPE AND TANK CAPACITY

Your vehicle has an 18.6 gallon (70.4L) fuel tank capacity. Your vehicle is designed to use "Regular" unleaded gasoline with an octane rating of 87. Do not use gasoline labeled as "Regular" in high altitude areas that are sold with Octane ratings less than 87. Your vehicle was not designed to run on E85 fuels that are blended with a maximum of 85% ethanol.

TIRE PRESSURE

Your tire pressure is properly set at the dealership according to the recommended specifications found on the Safety Compliance Certification Label or Tire Label located on the B-Pillar or the edge of the driver's door. Check your tire pressure at least once a month and before long trips (including spare, if equipped). As an added safety feature, your vehicle has been equipped with a Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) that illuminates a low tire pressure warning light when one or more of your tires is significantly under-inflated. Warning: Improperly inflated tires can affect vehicle handling and can fail suddenly, possibly resulting in loss of vehicle control. Refer to the Tires, Wheels and Loading chapter in your Owner's Guide for more information.

FUSES

If the vehicle's electrical components are not operating, a fuse may have blown. The fuse panel is located below the instrument panel on the driver's side and additional fuses are located in the power distribution box in the engine compartment. For more information, please refer to the Roadside Emergencies chapter of your Owner's Guide.

CHANGING THE TIRES

If you get a flat tire while driving, do not apply the brake heavily. Instead, gradually decrease your speed. Hold the steering wheel firmly and slowly move to a safe place on the side of the road. Your vehicle is equipped with either a temporary spare tire or a temporary mobility kit. The spare tire and jack are located under the carpeted floor panel in the rear of the vehicle. The temporary spare is designed for emergency use only and should be replaced as soon as possible.

The temporary mobility kit is located under the driver's seat and can be accessed by moving the driver's seat fully forward and releasing the VELCRO® strap, which attaches it to the seat frame. The kit contains an air compressor to re-inflate the tire and a sealing compound that will seal most punctures caused by nails or similar objects. The mobility kit will provide a temporary seal allowing you to drive up to 120 miles (200 km) at a maximum speed of 50 mph (80 km/h). After sealant use, the TPMS sensor and valve stem on the wheel must be replaced by an authorized Ford dealer. Note: The sealant in the canister is to be used for one tire only. See your authorized dealer for replacement canisters.

ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE

Your new Ford Flex comes with the assurance and support of 24-hour emergency roadside assistance. Roadside assistance includes such services as: lockout assistance, limited fuel delivery, battery jump starts, changing a flat tire (except vehicles that have been supplied with a temporary mobility kit), towing, and winch out. 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ANTI-LOCK BRAKE SYSTEM (ABS) WARNING LIGHT

The ABS light illuminates briefly when the ignition is turned on. If the ABS light remains on or continues to flash, a malfunction has been detected. Have the system serviced immediately by your authorized dealer. Normal braking (less ABS) is still functional unless the brake warning light (D) is also illuminated.

TEERING WHEEL CONTROLS (IF EQUIPPED)

The appearance and functionality of your vehicle's steering wheel controls may vary according to your option package. Refer to your Owner's Guide for a complete description of all possible options.

To set the speed control, press and release ON. Accelerate to the desired speed. Press and release the SET + or SET - control. Take your foot off the accelerator pedal. The speed control indicator light will illuminate in the cluster. To set a higher speed: press and hold SET+ until the desired speed is reached, or briefly press SET+ to increase the speed by small amounts. To set a lower speed: press and hold SET- until the desired speed is reached, or briefly press SET- to decrease the speed by small amounts. Press RESUME to return to the previously set speed. To turn speed control off, depress the brake pedal or press OFF.

Press – VOL + to decrease/increase the volume.

Press **I I** to access the previous/next preset radio station, CD track or preset satellite radio channel.

Press # to activate the Voice recognition system. Refer to your SYNC or Navigation supplement (if equipped) for more information.

Press MEDIA repeatedly to scroll through all possible media sources (AM, FM1, FM2, CD . . .etc).

Press 🔁 to answer a call if equipped with SYNC. Press and hold to end a call. Refer to your SYNC supplement for more information.

Press OK to confirm menu selections if equipped with SYNC.

MULTI-FUNCTION LEVER

Rotate the end of the control up to increase the speed of the wipers and rotate down to decrease the speed of the wipers. Briefly press the end of the stalk for a single swipe of the wipers without washer fluid. A quick push and hold results in three swipes with washer fluid while a longer push and hold activates the wash pattern for up to five seconds. For better visibility, your vehicle will also automatically turn on your headlights during daylight if your windshield wipers and auto lamps 🔆 are on. To operate your rear window wiper, turn the rear wiper control to 1 (intermittent speed), 2 (normal speed), or O (off). For a rear wash cycle, rotate and hold the rear wiper control to the 🛗 position.

MESSAGE CENTER

The message center displays important vehicle information through a constant monitoring of vehicle systems. The system will also notify you of potential vehicle problems with a display of system warnings followed by long indicator chime. Refer to your Owner's Guide for more information.

REVERSE SENSING

Your vehicle is equipped with a reverse sensing system which can warn you if there is an object behind the vehicle. The system will sound a warning tone that increases in frequency as the object gets closer and will sound continuously when the object is less than 10 inches away. The system turns on automatically when the ignition is on and the vehicle is placed in reverse (R). The system can be manually disabled through your message center controls. Warning: This system does not replace the need to watch where the vehicle is going and monitoring all surroundings when in reverse (R) because it may not be able to detect some objects. Refer to your Owner's Guide for more information.

HAZARD FLASHER

Press to activate the front and rear direction signals when your vehicle is disabled and is creating a safety hazard for other motorists. Press again to turn off. The hazard flashers will operate when the ignition is in any position or when the ignition is turned off.

ADVANCETRAC[®] WITH ROLL STABILITY CONTROL™

Your vehicle is equipped with an AdvanceTrac[®] stability system. This system consists of three main features: Traction Control[™] (helps avoid wheel spin and loss of traction), Electronic Stability Control (helps avoid skids or lateral slides), and Roll Stability Control[™] (helps avoid a vehicle roll-over). These features work together to help you to maintain stability and steerability of your vehicle during a variety of road conditions. If your vehicle becomes stuck in the snow, mud or sand, try turning off the AdvanceTrac[®] system to allow wheel spin and help increase momentum to dig the vehicle out. The system defaults to on and the control will illuminate when turned off.

SOUND: Press SOUND repeatedly to cycle through: Bass, Treble, Fade, Balance, DPS mode (if equipped Stereo Surround and Stereo modes) and Speed Compensated Volume. When the desired selection appears in the display, press ≤ SEEK to make adjustments.

DIRECT: Press DIRECT and then, using the memory presets (0-9), enter in the numbers of the desired station, track. MP3 folder or satellite channel.
