To fold down the rear seat, pull up on the lever on the outboard side of the seat cushion and let the seatback rotate downward into the load floor position. To return to the upright position, rotate the seatback upward until the seatback latches. The seatback will click when it is locked into position.

3 Front Heated and Cooled Seats

To activate these functions, press the buttons located on the climate control panel. Press 🕷 once for full heat or 🐃 once for full cool (three lights), twice for medium heat or medium cool (two lights) and a third time for low heat or low cool (one light).

The rear seat heat controls are located on the rear door panels. To operate the heated seats, push the top of the control for maximum heat, bottom of the control for minimum heat. Push again to deactivate.




