This article supersedes TSB **11-5-3** to update the Service Procedure.

ISSUE

Some 2010-2011 Taurus, Flex, MKS and MKT vehicles equipped with a 3.5L Gasoline Turbocharged Direct Injected (GTDI) engine may exhibit rough running, hesitation, shuddering with DTCs P0300, P0301, P0302, P0303, P0304, P0305, P0306 or P0316.

ACTION

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- Determine engine build date. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 303-01.
 - a. If engine build date is on or before 8/2/2010, proceed to Step 2.
 - b. If engine build date is after 8/2/2010, proceed to Step 5.
- 2. Retrieve DTCs to determine which cylinder has misfired.
- 3. Remove the spark plug of the affected cylinder. Refer to WSM, Section 303-07.
- 4. Check the spark plug for broken ceramic. (Figure 1)

- a. If the spark plug has broken ceramic or the part number is CYFS-12F-3, replace all six (6) spark plugs. Refer to WSM, Section 303-07. Proceed to Step 6.
- If the spark plug does not have broken ceramic and the part number is CYFS-12Y-3, do not replace spark plugs. Proceed to Step 6.
- Determine vehicle build date:

- a. If vehicle build date is on or before 10/27/2010, proceed to Step 6.
- b. If vehicle build date is after 10/27/2010, do not continue with this article. Refer to Powertrain Control/Emissions Diagnosis (PC/ED) manual for normal diagnostics.
- Reprogram the Powertrain Control Module (PCM) to the latest calibration using IDS release 72.03 and higher. This new calibration is not included in the VCM 2011.3 DVD. Calibration files may also be obtained at www.motorcraft.com.
